## **Update from Borough Councillors Stephen Moon and Sheryl Corp**

#### **East-West Rail**

The 5 possible routes for the proposed railway line linking Oxford to Cambridge have been announced. The routes are only sketched out as each is shown as a broad swathe of land within which the precise line has not been defined. Two of the possible routes pass through Bedford and then turn east; one of those, Route D, will pass close to the North of Brickhill/Woodlands Park, the edge of the strip shown on the plan being along Graze Lane and across the top of Cleat Hill.

Because of the geography of the area the line, if this route were to be chosen, is likely to cross the A660 Kimbolton Road closer to Ravensden Crossroads and is therefore unlikely to have any material impact on Brickhill. ## **Bromham Road Bridge**

The work to demolish and reconstruct the railway bridge over Bromham Road in the town centre has begun. This work is being undertaken to enable the electrification of the Midland Main Line.

Pedestrian access will still be allowed, but the road will be partially closed, meaning that drivers will need to follow a diversion via Clapham Road.

A feature of the new site is the inclusion of 'customer journeys' which aim to make it easier to report or discuss certain issues. For example, residents can now report potholes, graffiti and noise nuisance using the website. New customer journeys are undergoing testing and are being added to the site incrementally.
