Road resurfacing

We are pleased that we are to see Torridge Rise and Windrush resurfaced.

Tyne Crescent will also be resurfaced after we raised this with the highways inspection team at no cost to the council.

We did ask for the road in Brickhill Drive to be repaired and this has taken place

We have also asked for the shops car park in Avon Drive to be dealt with as it is poor condition and highways at Bedford Borough Council will be doing this, hopefully soon.

Travellers

The request for a high court injunction on Waveney Green has been placed before the court and we are just waiting for a date for the hearing. This will make it a criminal offence to put an encampment on there.

No Verge Parking

The zone in Moriston Road will be in place next week. There has been a delay in the council getting hold of the signs. The zone on roads off Bourneside is due to be put in soon and we have joint funded that with the parish council

Cameras at schools

These are in place now and producing enforcement fines

CCTV at Brickhill Drive

We had a request for this to be looked at and the camera is being upgraded.

There have been problems at the shops with begging and also burglaries at the newsagents.

School Crossing

There are concerns about the safety of children crossing Kimbolton Road. Brickhill Lower School have asked us to look at this and officers are producing a survey. It is not easy because where people cross is not where we could put a crossing, so we are seeing what we can do.

Manton Lane

There is a scheme forthcoming and it is hoped people will comment on it when it is produced. Please note that trees and hedges have already been removed to allow a widening of the road.

LED Lighting
