SAVE <u>YOUR</u> POST OFFICE!

The Government has announced that Post Office Ltd is to close 2,500 Post Offices across the country. Your local Post Office at Brickhill Drive is one of the Post Offices now threatened with closure. During the next few months a visiting team of Post Office "inspectors" will be coming to Bedford to decide which of our



Post Offices should close. Brickhill Parish Council believes that closing the Brickhill Drive Post Office would be disastrous for our community. So, together with our local Borough and County Councillors, we are campaigning to try to keep this Post Office open.

THREE THINGS YOU CAN DO TO HELP KEEP YOUR POST OFFICE OPEN:

- Sign our petition either at the Brickhill Drive Post Office or at the locations below or fill in the tear off slip below and send it back to us.
- **Display our poster** collect a poster from one of the contact points below and put this in your window or car. Please keep it displayed **until the end of April** when the "inspectors" will make their decision.
- Write or Email to the Parish Council (contact details below) send us a short letter or email to register your protest and explain how you would be affected if the Brickhill Drive Post Office closed down. For example, could you get transport to another Post Office easily? Would you find increased delays at another post office intolerable?

The petition and your letters will be given to the "inspectors". The more letters we give them the better chance we have of keeping **your** Post Office open.

Postmaster Bobby Chambers says "For the past 13 years I have worked hard to give a friendly, helpful and valuable service to the Brickhill community. I strongly believe that, with all your support, we will be able to see off this threat hanging over us."

A grant of £50,000 from WREN means that refurbishment work can be done to include a new roof, lighting flooring and decorating of the large community hall which is used by many local groups.

BRICKHILL PARISH COUNCIL BUDGET 2008/9

In 2008/9 the Parish Council will be collecting a total of £52,200 from the Council Taxpayers of Brickhill which represents an increase of 4.5% on the amount of £49,950 collected in 2007/8. This means an average Brickhill household (ie a Band D household) will pay £16.02 for the year. This money (known as the Precept) goes to support the Parish Council in its work for the benefit of the local community.

The Parish Council set its detailed budget at a meeting on 10 January 2008 and a copy is available on the website, along with last year's accounts. Please contact me if you would like to a paper copy of the budget or have any questions about the Parish Council's finances or any aspect of its business. This year's accounts will be available after the end of the financial year on 31 March 2008.
