BRICKHILL PARISH COUNCIL BUDGET 2010/11

In 2010/11 the Parish Council will collect a total of £57,700 from the Council Taxpayers of Brickhill. This money (known as the Precept) supports the Parish Council in its work for the benefit of the local community. The 2009-10 Precept was £52,000; for a Band D property this is an increase of £1.82 per year. The Parish Council was conscious of the need to balance income against expenditure, while being mindful of the generally difficult economic situation. Various plans for expenditure were either removed from the budget or cut back, to keep the increase down. The budget will still enable the continuation of the Police Post at St Mark's, further events such as a 'Gathering on the Green' in the Summer, Community Grants and work to improve the Allotments.

A copy of the detailed budget is available on the website, along with last year's accounts. Please contact the Clerk if you would like a hard copy of the budget or have any questions about the Parish Council's finances or any aspect of its business. The 2009-10 accounts will be available after the end of the financial year on 31 March 2010.


