## **Policing in Brickhill**

The police have identified burglary as the main issue for Brickhill in their priority setting. Please do let our police team know if you have anybody who is concerned about burglary. The police have offered to visit homes of residents to give advice regarding home security.

## **Transporting Bedford 2020**

**Manton Lane.** Work has been continuing at Manton Lane on widening works. Work is behind schedule although works to install the retaining wall alongside the school playing fields has now commenced after some delay. Works in association with installing a gas main to the Fairhills development have been taking place over half term with Transporting Bedford 2020 works taking place overnight. Discussions are ongoing with the contractor to find ways of accelerating the programme and in particular to shorten the time required for utility company works.

**Britannia Road –** Works on Britannia Road will start on Saturday 20 July and continue through to the New Year. A one way system will be in place for the majority of the works period (traffic prohibited from travelling southbound on Britannia Road).

**High Street –** Consultation will be taking place for work to start next year **Ampthill Road –** Data is being collected on origin and destination surveys to be used to refine the traffic model to test possible layouts for Ampthill Road.

### **Bromham Railway Bridge**

Network Rail has announced when Bromham Road bridge will fully close to vehicles as work continues as part of the Midland Main Line Upgrade. From Monday, 24 June work will continue to divert utilities and services away from the bridge in preparation for the structure to be demolished and reconstructed at a raised height. To allow this work to take place safely, Bromham Road will be fully closed to vehicles until 12 April 2020. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout the closure. During this time, a diversionary route via the A6 and Clapham Road will be in place. This will be clearly sign-posted.

The reconstruction will begin in Autumn this year and complete in December. This work will provide a safe distance for the overhead line equipment passing beneath, enabling the line between Bedford, Kettering and Corby to be electrified as part of the Midland Main Line Upgrade.

The demolition and reconstruction will be carried out using a crane which will be parked in Bedford station car park from Monday, 14 October until Sunday, 22 December. This will reduce parking at the station during this time.

Network Rail, Govia Thameslink Railway and Bedford Borough Council are working together on keeping disruption to a minimum whilst this takes place. For more information on alternative car
