## BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (BEDFORD URBAN AREA (NORTH OF THE RIVER EXCLUDING QUEENS PARK AND CPZ AREAS)) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009 (AMENDMENT NO.69) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 25<sup>th</sup> August 2021 Bedford Borough Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which is detailed below:-

## **Effect of the Order:**

1. To introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road:

Α	Rooksmead, Bedford
(i)	On its south-western kerb, extending from the westernmost point of the
	parking bays that front 94 to 74 Rooksmead for a distance of approximately 9
	metres in a north-westerly direction.
(ii)	On its southern kerb, extending from the easternmost point of the parking
	bays that front 94 to 74 Rooksmead for a distance of approximately 25 metres
	in an easterly direction.

<u>Date of Operation:</u> This Order will come into force on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2021 or as soon as practicable after this date.

<u>A copy</u> of the Order may be examined during normal office hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, MK42 9AP. It can also be viewed on the Council's website at www.bedford.gov.uk/implementedtro.

<u>High Court Challenge:</u> Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date of this Notice, make application for that purpose to the High Court.
