



PUBLIC NOTICE

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSE TO INTRODUCE SOME PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN NIGHTINGALE AVENUE, BEDFORD

Reason for Proposal:

Bedford Borough Council has received complaints about the inconsiderate parking of vehicles at a junction in Nightingale Avenue, Bedford. This junction leads to garages at the rear of properties and so is regularly used for access. However, the concern is that the parked vehicles affect access and visibility, and hence safety, at this junction, so these restrictions are intended to remedy that.

Effect of the Order:

1. To introduce 'No waiting and no loading at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines and double yellow kerb blips) on the following lengths of road:

A	Nightingale Avenue, Bedford
(i)	On its western kerb, extending from the northernmost point of the rear wall of number 4 Hawk Drive, Bedford in a southerly and then westerly direction for a distance of approximately 24 metres.
(ii)	On its eastern kerb, extending from a point opposite the northernmost point of the rear wall of number 4 Hawk Drive, Bedford in a southerly and then easterly direction for a distance of approximately 26 metres.

A copy of this Notice, a draft Order, a plan, and a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined during normal office hours at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford, MK42 9AP, and will be placed on deposit until 6 weeks after the Order is made or until it is decided not to continue with the proposal.
