

Action Plan 2022-23

Brickhill Parish Council aims to identify how its community can be best served by setting out an action plan. Whilst this covers a three year period, it can be reviewed as needed with actions added or removed as required.

• Waveney Green:

- i) to develop a new three year plan for Waveney Green 2022-25 to include the following:
 - a) footpath maintenance
 - b) the play areas
 - c) the wildflower meadow
 - d) to consider developing a Tree Management Strategy
- ii) to continue to review and develop parish council events held on the Green e.g. Gathering on the Green and the tree light switch-on in December
- iii) Once Bedford Borough Council has produced a policy for the users of its open spaces, the Parish Council will consider adapting it to provide a policy for users of Waveney Green

Allotments:

- i) to develop a new three year plan for 2022-25
- ii) to ensure that the allotments are operated in an efficient and cost effective manner to the benefit of the allotment holders and the wider community
- iii) to identify potential environmental improvements

- iv) To move all communication with allotment holders to e-mail in order to reduce postage costs
- v) To work towards moving payments of allotment rents away from cheque and cash to electronic methods

• Woodlands Park:

- i) the parish council aims to drive forward the work on the projects identified in the consultation
- ii) to work with Bedford Borough Council in developing the area and its amenities

• Mowsbury Walk Play Area:

To develop a three year plan for maintenance and improvement

• Neighbourhood Development Plan:

To actively work towards the production of the plan

• Brickhill Community Centre:

To liaise with the Management Committee regarding future capital investment

Staffing:

To encourage staff to attend training sessions in order to enhance their skills in order to better fulfil the requirements of their employment as well as to develop them as individuals

• General aims:

- i) to meet the requirements in order to renew quality status for the parish council
- ii) to continue to support local groups through publicity and grants
- iii) to ensure that Brickhill is represented on local groups and associations
- iv) to improve communication with residents
- v) to encourage community action through litter picks and community bulb planting
