

Brickhill – data and analysis from Census 2021

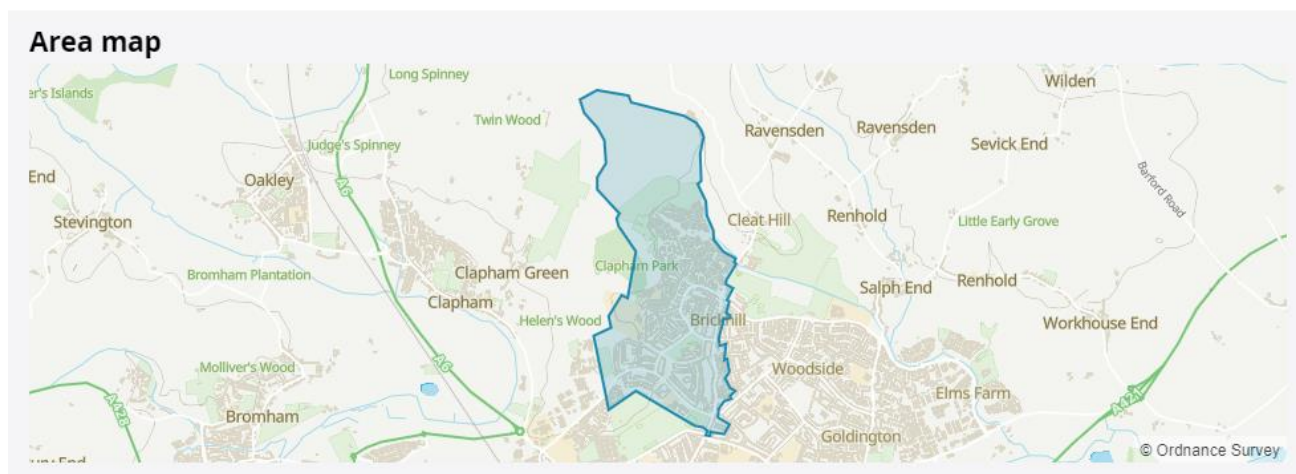
The Office for National Statistics (ONS) has published 34 sets of information about the parish of Brickhill, Bedford. It gives a complete picture of the enlarged parish for the first time, as the 2011 census took place before the parish boundaries changed.

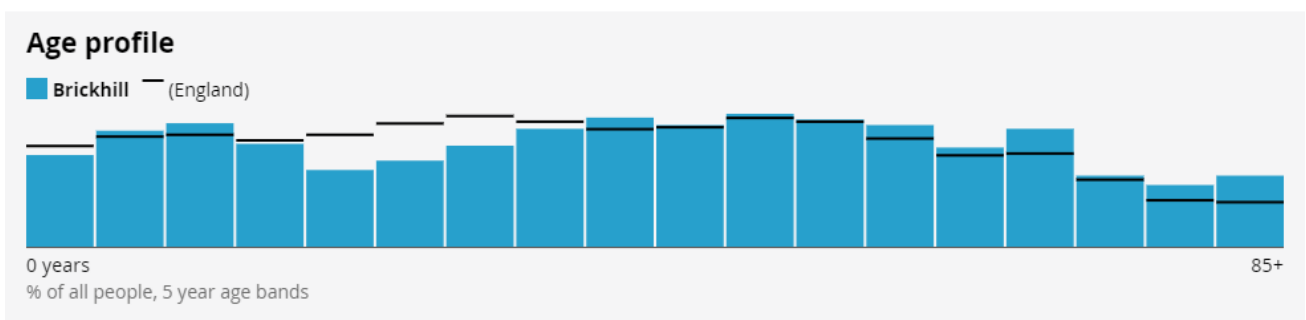
